

AI GOVERNANCE CHECKLIST FOR HEALTHCARE ORGANIZATIONS

A Self-Assessment Tool for Identifying Governance Gaps in Al Deployments

Instructions: For each question, mark YES or NO. If you answer NO to any question, you likely have a governance gap.

Have you reviewed federal requirements (HIPAA, FDA, OCR) for your Al system? Do you know which states you operate in and their specific consent/recording laws? Are you aware of the Joint Commission's RUAIH guidance (September 2025)? Have you assessed whether your Al system meets FDA's medical device definition? VENDOR CONTRACTS & DATA SECURITY Does your contract clearly define data ownership and usage rights? Have you reviewed your Business Associate Agreement for Al-specific provisions? Do you have audit rights to review vendor's Al models and data practices? Does your contract limit how vendors use your data for "training"?

Are there SLA commitments on accuracy (not just uptime)?

PATIENT RIGHTS & CONSENT Do you obtain explicit patient consent in two-party consent states? Do patients know when AI is being used in their care? Do you have state-specific consent forms (not generic HIPAA)? Can patients opt out of AI use without penalty? **CLINICAL OVERSIGHT & QUALITY** Do you have documented protocols for physician review of AI outputs? Is there ongoing quality monitoring of AI performance? Do you have a process for detecting and reporting AI errors? Have clinicians been trained on Al limitations and proper use? **GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE** Do you have a formal Al governance committee? Is there a designated leader responsible for AI oversight? Are Al policies and procedures documented? Does your board receive regular updates on AI use? **BIAS & EQUITY** Have you assessed your AI system for algorithmic bias? Do you monitor for disparate outcomes across patient populations? ___ Was the AI trained on representative datasets?

SCORING YOUR RESULTS

20+ YES: Strong governance foundation

15-19 YES: Moderate governance gaps (assessment recommended)

10-14 YES: Significant governance gaps (assessment strongly recommended)

Under 10 YES: Critical governance gaps (immediate assessment needed)
